

SELLERSBURG CELEBRATES! PARADE RULES

1. All applications for parade participants are subject to the approval of the Sellersburg Celebrates! Parade Committee.
1. Line up of the parade may be somewhat determined by the date of the application as well as appropriateness.
1. All entries are approved upon the Parade Chairman receiving the parade application. Any concerns on behalf of the Parade Committee will be addressed with the individual responsible for the unit by the Parade Chairman receiving the application.
1. Units should **ONLY** arrive at the **PRATHER LANE** entrance to the Haas Cabinet Companies parking lot by 8:30 a.m. on the date of the parade. All entries will receive their parade assignment positions, from parade officials, at this time.
1. No entries should be decorated in a way that will impede the driver's vision or create a fire hazard.

1. All persons on riding entries must have handholds or another safety support.

1. Material, such as candy, toys, gum, etc., may be TOSSED, but NEVER THROWN!

1. Floats or other units breaking down during the parade will be cleared from the parade route.

1. Floats or other units slowing or impeding the movement of the parade will be asked by Sellersburg Police Officers to catch up and close gaps. Non compliance and the Floats or other units may be removed from the parade route.

- 1. Floats or other units should attempt to carry out the festival theme, which is, “We are having fun in 2021”.**

1. Candidates for political office may be represented. Placement in the line will be based on the order parade applications are received by the Parade Committee.

1. Sellersburg Celebrates! Parade Awards will be presented along the parade route and during the

parade. Judging will take place during the line up from 8:30 a.m. – 9:45 a.m.

1. Any parade unit that attempts to walk the parade route (i.e. cheerleaders, elderly and kids, martial artist, politicians, tumblers, etc.) must be accompanied by a vehicle that can transport tired walkers at any given time along the parade route.
1. Any parade unit that wishes to perform a routine (i.e. cheer, dance, martial art, tumble, etc.) is allowed to perform once every one hundred yards and the routine can last no longer than one minute. This is to keep the parade flowing smoothly.
1. In order to keep the parade route clean and safe for all involved, all animal unit entries must have necessary equipment to clean up after their animals
1. The parade route ends on South Fern Street at the entrance of Silver Creek Community Park. There are ONLY 2 drop off/ pick up locations. The field next to J.L. Gilbert Cabinets at the end of the parade route and the Silver Creek Primary School.

1. The Sellersburg Celebrates! Parade Committee may find it necessary to institute other rules as parade plans progress. We will keep you informed of any changes.
